<u>Friends of Brayton Barff</u> A site visit regarding Yorkshire Water's plans for a new borehole will take place on 13th January. Mr Cooper has concerns regarding this work and the impact on plants and wildlife.

The removal of tree guards event was cancelled on 7th December due to high winds – it has now been rearranged for Saturday 18th January at 10am. Cr. V Griffiths reported that the problem with rats on the Barff still remains, with bird feeder contents being the main attraction for the vermin. The Clerk will discuss this with FOBB.

<u>Parish Liaison</u> There will be a Drop In meeting on 16th Jan at Hambleton Village Halll 10am – 4pm. This is to enable North Yorkshire Council to have better communication links with parish Councils in the area.

Wayleaves Three of the wayleaves have already been paid. We are just waiting on the Schools payment.

 $\underline{Road\ Closures}$ The railway crossing on Brayton Lane will be closed on 10^{th} January 00.01-5am and on 19^{th} January between 5am-10am

<u>Evans Homes</u> A sign has been erected on Barff Lane advertising the new Brayton Beacons Estate. The Clerk has emailed Evans Homes for more information.

<u>Christmas Lighting</u> The Clerk reported that the lights had been much better over the last month with all the tree lights staying on. The only issue seemed to be the 'Gingerbread Man' Light and this was thought to be because of the location – the Clerk will ask for this to be moved in December 2025.

- c) <u>Brayton Community Centre</u> Thank you email for the recent cheque of £10,000 to fund the Youth Club for the next 12 months, they will attend a meeting in the next few months to give an update. Members discussed issues in Brayton and had concerns with the large amount of Youths on electric scooters travelling at high speeds and with no lights, the Clerk will mention this to both the Police and the Youth Workers to see if they can have a positive effect on this problem. Cr. M Bontoft reported that the lights at the Sports Wall remain on at 11pm the Clerk will contact the Electricians to readjust the timers.
